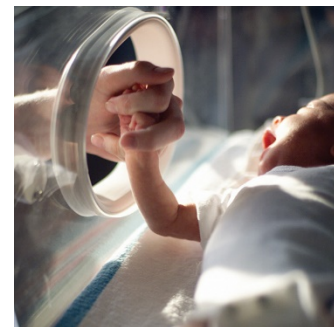

How you can help

Providence cares for more of Oregon's children than anyone else. More than half of these children and their mothers are among our state's most vulnerable citizens. They need your support more than ever before. Here are some areas where your help is needed now.

- **Center for Medically Fragile Children:** Provide children and young people with profound disabilities and complex medical needs with compassionate care at the Center for Medically Fragile Children, including music therapy, massage, specialized equipment and medically-appropriate transportation.
- **Swindells Resource Center:** Assist more than 20,000 families and caregivers of children with special health care needs with peer support, free educational resources and webinars through the Swindells Resource Center.
- **Newborn services:** Enhance care for more than 900 babies each year in Providence's neo-natal intensive care units by providing family supports, safe sleep sacks for newborns, and state-of-the-art incubators for premature infants.
- **Newborn research:** Discover simple ways to ensure babies are healthy from day one through research in newborn brain development, improving breathing and nourishment of premature infants and reducing the U.S. maternity mortality rate, the highest in the industrialized world.

- **Camp Erin:** Comfort children coping with the death of a loved one through professional therapy, poetry, art, music and physical activities at Camp Erin for Grieving Children.
- **Child life specialists:** Help children manage the fear and stress of their own or a family member's illness, injury or hospitalization with the support of certified child life specialists.
