Pandemic changes how we care for our garden

To keep patients and residents safe during this time of COVID-19, our dedicated volunteers have not been able to maintain the gardens. This means we've had the additional expense of paying an outside company to provide necessary garden maintenance.

With your generous support, our Garden Endowment Fund has grown to \$150,000 – more than halfway to our goal of \$250,000! Earnings from the endowment pay for garden upkeep and plant purchases. The Garden Committee has determined we need to reach the full \$250,000 goal so that endowment earnings can fully support the yearly garden maintenance expenses.
