On this special evening, we invite children and their guardians, who may not be able to afford festival tickets, to attend this free, invitation-only event. They will delight in the magic of Christmas as they view the trees, visit with Santa, check out Teddy Bear Hospital and more!
- Festival of Trees limited public viewing at the Medford Armory | Dec. 3–4: Limited viewing will be available on a first-come basis by purchasing tickets online to view our beautifully decorated Christmas trees.

Festival of Trees has played a vital role in funding programs and services that enable Providence to meet our goal of improving health in our community, especially for those who are poor and vulnerable. Here's a look back at our past five festivals.

2017 Swindells Resource Center -

Swindells Resource Center is 100% funded by philanthropy and supports parents and caregivers of children with special health care needs. The festival helped us:

- Hire a family navigator to support families after a child's diagnosis
- Expand a free resource library
- Provide Care Notebooks that help maintain the complex records of a child's care

- 2019 Palliative Care -

Palliative care helps families manage a patient's physical, psychological, social and spiritual needs. The festival helped the program:

- Offer counseling following a diagnosis of a serious or chronic condition
- Provide patient-family case management and care coordination
- Help patients navigate the complicated medical system
- Assist in planning for end-of-life needs

2021 Caregiver Education -

Caregiver Scholarships provide financial support to Providence employees who are pursuing degrees in nursing or other health care career. fields. The festival helped us:

- Expand the existing nursing scholarship fund and offer more scholarships to caregivers
- Establish a new scholarship fund that supports caregivers in all areas of health care

2018 Providence BirthPlace

Providence BirthPlace in Medford delivers more than 600 babies each year and provides a personal birthing experience for each patient.

- Expand BirthPlace programs and services for mothers and their babies
- Purchase new equipment

2020 Caregiver Support -

COVID-19 changed the world and, in the same year, southern Oregon communities faced devastating wildfires. The festival helped us:

- Cover childcare expenses in partnership with the YMCA when schools closed
- Expand our nursing education fund as the need for health care workers increased
- Provide hotel stays and purchase RVs for caregivers whose homes were affected by wildfire
- Bolster the Helping Hand fund to assist caregivers facing financial crisis
