# 2022 GENEROUS HEART HONOREES MARY BETH AND TIM HERMAN

Mary Beth and Tim Herman share a passion for supporting causes that expand access to services that improve the quality of life in our community. The Hermans first met in 2009 and were married in 2011. Together Mary Beth and Tim have five grown children and a total of seven grandchildren. Most of their time is spent in volunteering and enjoying their families.

Mary Beth, who is an account executive at Napa Valley Marketplace, has served on multiple nonprofit boards including Kiwanis, Grad-Nite, and Leadership Napa Valley. She is a founding member of the widely supported 100 Women Who Care, which has provided funding to numerous worthy local nonprofits to advance their services.



Throughout his professional career Tim has designed and produced equipment to protect the

environment from toxic gases. His background in engineering science led him to design and patent equipment for the Semiconductor Industry, which led to the founding of Airprotek Inc., a pollution control company. He then merged this company with Innovative Engineering to form Delatech Inc., where, as COO, Tim helped to build the company to a multi-million-dollar enterprise.

Proceeds from the sale of Delatech enabled Tim to establish the Herman Family Foundation, which supports education and Christian values, and the International Children's Dream Foundation, which focuses on empowering children to strengthen their skills in conflict resolution and cope with substance abuse.

Tim has served as past chair of the board of Queen of the Valley Medical Center and past president of Queen of the Valley Medical Center Foundation. He is a past president of the boards of Justin Siena High School and of St. Apollinaris Catholic School, a member of the board of the Elaine Mackie Charitable Trust and a past member of the Napa Valley Medical Foundation. Tim currently serves as vice chair of the Providence Health System regional board.

In 2007, Tim's first wife Peggy died due to head injuries suffered in a riding accident. In the process of trying to save her life, Tim was troubled to discover that there were no neuro-surgeons practicing in Napa Valley at that time. He began to think about the future. What about those whose lives could depend on having immediate access to a neuro-surgeon's skills?

To provide our community with this critical medical resource, the Herman family helped start the Peggy Herman Neuroscience Center. A joint venture with UCSF, the alliance now ensures that a world-class neurosurgeon will be available locally in case of an emergency.

In 2013 Mary Beth and Tim made the decision to donate \$11 million toward the completion of the Queen's new surgical/diagnostic center. The Herman Family Pavilion, opened in 2014, boasts six state-of-the art surgical suites, 20 intensive care suites and one of the most sophisticated clinical laboratories in the country.

#### OUR BENEFICIARY: A 3T-MRI FOR THE NAPA VALLEY COMMUNITY

With your support, Providence Queen of the Valley Medical Center has delivered cuttingedge technologies and services to detect and diagnose ailments and diseases sooner – for all those that live and work here.

Technology advancements offer improved healthcare outcomes for patients. A 3T MRI at the Queen will be the only one of its kind in Napa County serving our population. Currently, patients must travel outside the area for this level of diagnostic as prescribed by their physician.

Tesla(T) is the unit of measurement quantifying the strength of a magnetic field. Prior to 3T Technology, the high-field standard in MR Imagining was 1.5 Tesla. The 3T MRI Scanner

generates a magnetic field that is twice the strength of a 1.5 Tesla system and 10 to 15 times the strength of low-field or open MRI scanners. The magnetic field produced by a 3T MRI system yields exceptional anatomic detail and resolution. The increased image clarity revealed by a 3T MRI system is particularly beneficial for pathological conditions involving the brain, spine, breast, body, and musculoskeletal system. The increased spatial resolution of a 3T scanner also allows for high-quality vascular and cardiac imaging.

Providence Queen of the Valley Medical Center's Profili Imaging Center currently owns two of the older generation 1.5T MRIs. Purchasing a new 3T MRI will allow the replacement of the older of the two MRI systems which is the 2004 system that is now outdated and has completely depreciated. The new system would provide a cutting-edge and necessary platform to serve our most critically ill patients while also advancing the procedures and supporting growth in service lines such as Oncology, Orthopedics, Cardiovascular Medicine, and Neuroscience.

The 1,100-acre Hine Ranch owned by the Cervantes family is one of the rare remaining large parcels of land in the Napa Valley. Exploring this paradisal property at the southern end of Pope Valley is ideal on horseback. Six guests will be fortunate enough to do just that accompanied by the "three amigos": Xavier Cervantes, whose estate vineyard covers 90 acres of the ranch, Juan Puentes of Honrama Cellars, and Lee Hudson of Hudson Ranch.
