We've put together [this impact report](#) to thank our donors and help demonstrate the importance and role of philanthropy in keeping our medical center (and our residents) healthy.

This year, more than \$700,000 has already been invested in areas both big and small: from a \$10 pair of shoes for a patient who rolled into a campfire and gift cards for personal care items to a rapid testing platform and a portable ultrasound to prepare Southgate as a temporary hospital for additional beds (thankfully, the additional beds have not been needed).

I have the privilege to lead a dedicated group of volunteers who fundraise in support of Providence St. Mary Medical Center. Right now, we're focused on 3 key areas:

- Growing mental health resources
- Funding heart monitors for babies
- Increasing unrestricted support so we can continue to respond, as we have done during the pandemic, to current and future needs

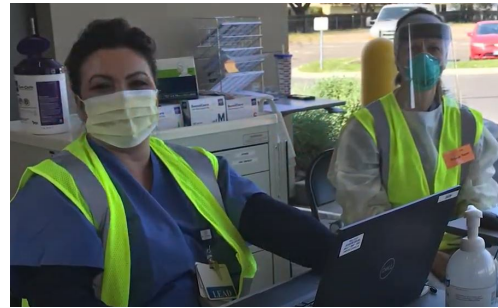
